City Manager – Scott Moore

Local Event Permits

Manager Moore shared with council that he developed a summary of the local event permit process. There is a packet of paperwork that needs to be completed by the applicant 30 days prior to the event. We have an event committee which consists of Manager Moore, Clerk/Treasurer Wells and Police Chief Thompson. They review the application to determine if the event could cause any safety concerns, or if a street closure is needed. There are guidelines based on the size of the event that need to be followed. They also need to provide proof of insurance for the event. The person who signs the application is held responsible if there is any damage to city property during the event.
